Our friend, Sgt. Joseph M. Nolan, was much more than just a hero in Operation Iraqi Freedom. Joe was also our son, our brother, and our best friend. He was the smartest and wittiest man you could ever know. His thirst for knowledge and experience led him all over the globe and eventually to the deserts of Iraq to both defend America and help in the liberation of the Iraqi people. After graduating from St. Joseph's University in Philadelphia with degrees in Japanese and International Relations in 1999, Joe joined the U.S. Army where he was a member of the 312th Military Intelligence Battalion, 1st Cavalry Division, out of Fort Hood, TX. His interest in, and aptitude for, foreign languages would lead to his being chosen to attend a highly selective, 63-week course in Arabic at the Defense Language Institute in Monterey, California. The fall of 2003 found him in Baghdad. In early November 2004, he was sent to Fallujah to provide critical-language and cryptologic support to coalition troops in the area. He was killed on November 18, 2004 by an improvised explosive device while on patrol in Fallujah, Iraq.
